

Global Week Prize Draw Competition Standard Terms and Conditions

1. Competition Introduction

NTU is running a free-to-enter prize draw competition to register students attending the Global Week 2019 fairs and performances. One winner will receive a prize of a £200 Travel Voucher issued by Diversity travel and sponsored by NTU Global (Voucher usage will be subject to the Suppliers' terms and conditions). To enter the competition students must register their student number to a recognized 'Global Week 2019' event between Monday 25 February to Friday 1 March across City, Clifton and Brackenhurst campuses.

All information detailing how to enter this competition forms part of these terms and conditions. It is a condition of entry that all rules are accepted as final and that the entrant agrees to abide by these rules. Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.

The information given in these terms and conditions is correct, but the University reserve the right to change any of the terms and conditions without prior notice.

2. Terms and conditions

2.1 – Who can enter:

This competition is open to all students of Nottingham Trent University, Confetti and Nottingham Trent International College (including without limitation: visiting students and NTU students currently on study exchange, traineeships, or volunteering abroad).

2.2 – How the winner will be chosen:

The winner will be chosen at random during the week commencing 4 March 2019 and announced that week.

2.3 – How an entry can be made:

Entries must be submitted by students by providing their student number when attending Global Week fairs taking place between 25 February and 1 March at City and Clifton Campuses, Tuesday 26 February and Thursday 28 February at Brackenhurst, and performances at Old Chemistry Theatre at City Campus throughout the week.

Brackenhurst fairs will take place on Tuesday and Thursday, on other days students can register their numbers by visiting Employability Team at Bramley Building between 11am – 3 pm, or visit other campuses.

Each student can register their student number once per day per campus at a recognised registration point – Global Week staff members (wearing orange T-shirts) or Brackenhurst Employability Team members will be collecting the numbers on electronic tablets and iPads via an online app Akkroo during Global Week Fairs and at Brackenhurst Employability desk at Bramley Building.

2.4 – What the entry should include:

All entries must include your student number.

2.5 – What the entrant agrees to upon submission:

By entering the competition, you:

- Confirm that the entry you submit and your personal data received by the University in the course of the promotion are subject to the University's privacy policy.
- Agree to your name being used in the announcement of the competition results.
- Agree to abide by the rules of the competition.

2.6 – The deadline for entries:

The closing date for entries is Friday 1 March 2019 at 3.00pm.

2.7 – How the winner will be chosen:

The winner will be chosen at random from all entries submitted throughout Global Week across all campuses.

2.8 – One or more entries?

Only one entry can be submitted per student per campus (City, Clifton, Brackenhurst) per day - maximum 3 entries per day during Global Week 2019 from 25 February 2019 to 1 March 2019.

Maximum 15 entries per person in total.

Once you register with staff during fairs, you will receive a Global Week sticker, which we will ask you to wear during the fair or performances. This is to prove that you have registered for the competition on the particular day and campus.

2.9 – No alternatives to the prize stated:

No cash alternative to the stated prize(s) will be offered. The prize is not transferable.

2.10 – How will results be announced:

Competition results will be announced on Social Media channels the week commencing 4 March 2019, the winner will be notified by email.

2.11 – When will the winner be announced:

The NTU Global Team will announce winners during the week commencing 4 March 2019.
